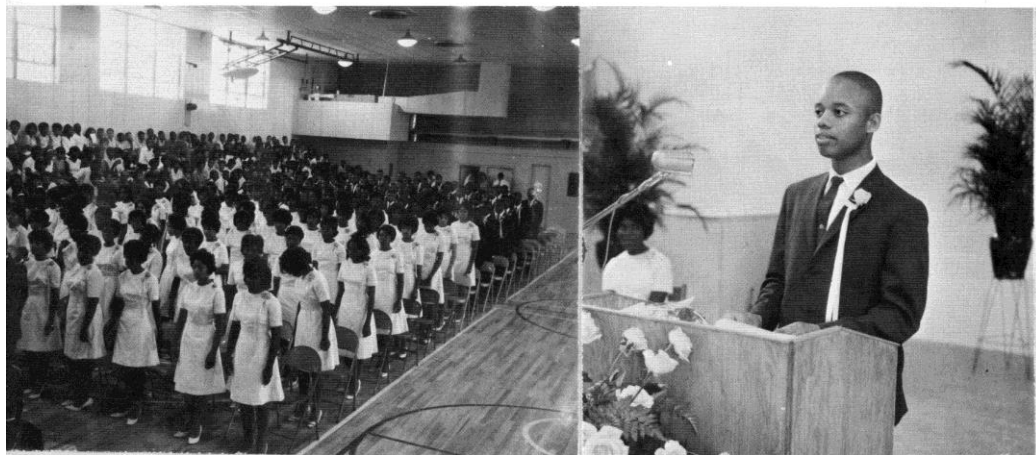


J. S. CLARK school band, pictured here, rated

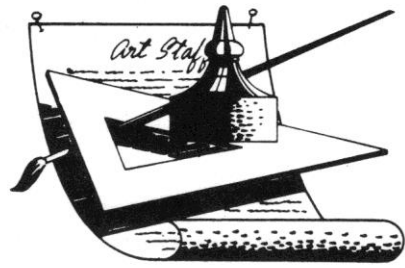
