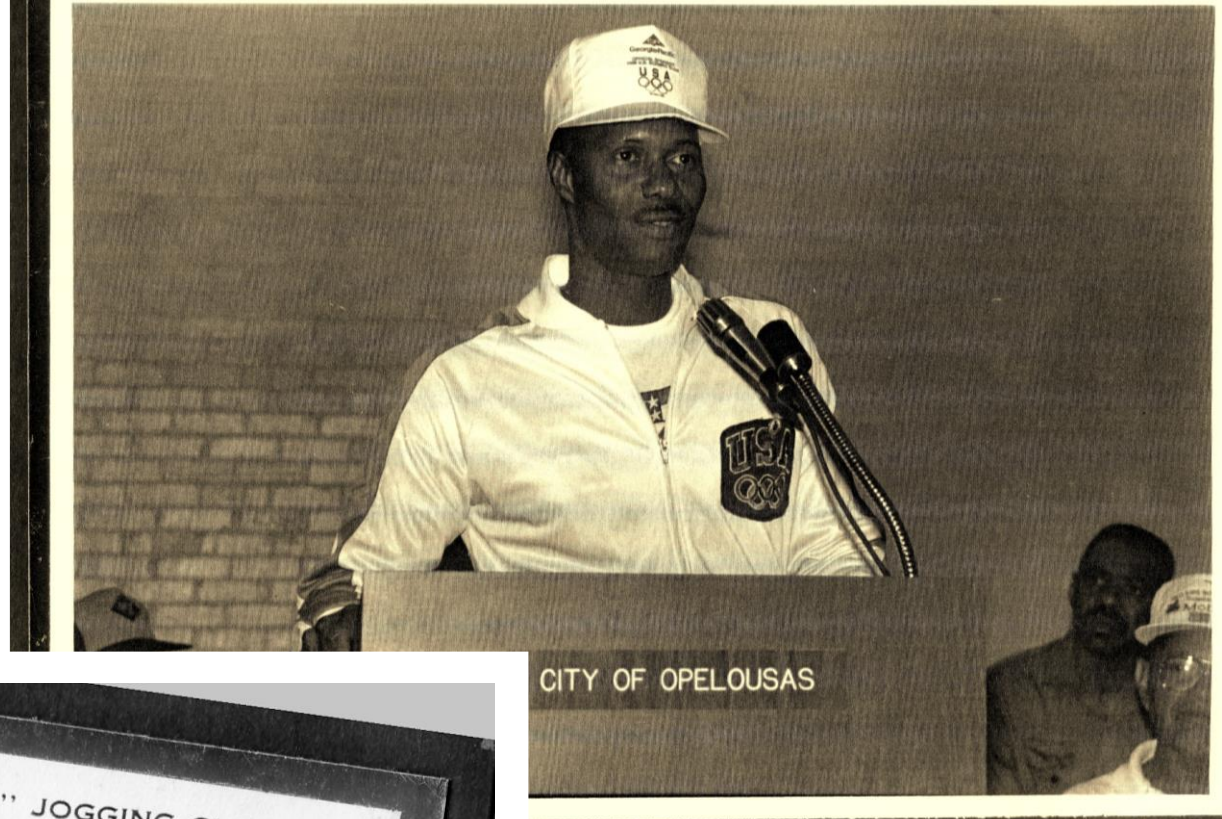





A sure thing true to form

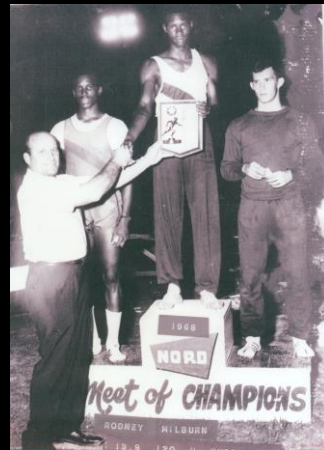

RODNEY MILBURN (second from left) holder of the national high school record in the 120 yard high hurdles signed a grant-in-aid to attend Southern University Monday evening. The 18 year old youth who attended J. S. Clark High in Opelousas also ran off with first place in the event during the LIALO State Championship and the J. S. Clark Relays with times of 13.6 and 13.5 for the 39" hurdles in the same distance. His record of 13.7 for the "42" high was set at the National Prep Meet held in Sacramento, California in June. Milburn has also won meets at Huston and New Orleans. The versatile trackster, in addition to his hurdling feats, participated as a member of the 220, 440 and 880 relay teams at his high school. Milburn, who chose Southern over more than twenty other major college offers was coached by Claude Paxton, Sr. (right.) Present at the signing were his mother, Mrs. Mary Milburn, (second from right) his coach and Coach Horace Moody (left) representing Southern.
